3. Summary of the Suras

Sura Al Fil
<p>Sura Al Fil is only Allah's inflicting. His punishment on the people of the elephants was an event of recent occurrence and everyone in Makkah and Arabia was fully aware of it. The Arabs believed that the Ka'abah had been protected in this invention, not by any God and Goddess but by Almighty Allah himself. For quite a few years the people of Quraish have been impressed by this event, had worshiped none but Allah. Then completely and destroyed the people of the elephants. For the only message that he gave was that they should worship and serve none but Allah the only one and one. That's why Allah revealed this sura to Prophet (sm) to give warning of Quraish and general people of Arabia.</p>
Sura Al Quraish
<p>It is Makki sura. It urges the Qurayya tribe who dominated Mecca to serve God, who had protected them, for the sake of their future. It is one of the two suras containing 4 ayat. It forms a pair preceding with Sura Al Fil reminding the Quraish of the favor that God had bestowed on him.</p> <p>The Ka'aba was center of the life of the Quraish, being a center of the Pilgrimage which brought much trade and prestige.</p>
Sura Al Maun
<p>Al Maun means kindness. It is the 107th Sura of the Quran with 7 ayat. This sura concerned with two of the core teachings of Islam, how one prays and how one gives. The sura discussed about character of those who claim to be Muslims but are believers of the hereafter.</p>



Sura Al Kausar

Surah Kausar sums up the the doctrine of spiritual riches through devotion and sacrifice. This sura is formost directly addressed to our Prophet (SM) and through him the rest of the Muslims. It is the 108th and the shortest surah of the Quran. It gave massage about the monumental importance about hope. This surah was revealed in an especially difficult time in the life of Prophet (SM).

Sura Al Kaferun

Sura Al Kaferun is also a shortest sura in the Quran. This Sura discussed about the unbelievers of Gad and Islam. here one need to keep in mind that separation between believers and disbelievers of Islam. This is an warning about the newly founded Muslims minority in Macca against the disbelievers.
