Title with Names

Title	Used for
Mr.	-For men -Can be used with full name or last name -Ex: Mr. Shakib Al-Hasan Mr. Hasan
Mrs.	- For married women - Can be used with full name or with the husband's last name - Ex: Mrs. SamiaShafiq Mrs. Shafiq
Ms.	-Can be used for all women -Ex: Ms. Monowara Begum Ms. Shaila Ahmed (it does not tell if the woman is married or not)

Names:

(* last name is also called surname)
