WH-Words	Usage	Example
Who	Used to identify a person	Who is she?
What	Used to identify a thing	What is it?
Where	Used to identify a place	Where is she?
Which	Used to tell two (or more) things apart.	Which bag is yours?
When	Used to identify time	When is your birthday?
Why	Used to identify a reason	Why is she crying?
How	Used to explain a way/method	How did you make the cake?
Whose	Used to identify possession	Whose car is that?
How long	Used to explain length or duration	How long is your holiday?
How much/many	Used to identify quantity	How much money do you have?

Formation of WH-Question:

1. WH-Words + Auxiliary verb (be, do or have) + Subject

Example: Where is she?

WH-words Aux. V Sub

2. WH-Words + Auxiliary verb (be, do or have) + Subject + main verb + Object (if any)

Example: a. wheredoeshelive?

WH-Words Aux. verb Subject Main Verb

b. What did Rajudoto put out the fire?

Wh-words Aux.V Sub Main.V Obj.
