1) What is the meaning of Mosque? Write the names and locations of two mosques honored by the Muslims in the world (2018)

Answer:

Mosque: The meaning of Mosque is the place for Sijdah. The another name of Mosque is Masjid.

There are three dignified mosques in the world. The two mosques honoured the muslims in the world are given below-

1. Masjid-e-Haram(The Ka'aba)	►Makkah
2. Masjid-e-Nababi	►Madina

2) How many Wajibs are there in Salat? Write any 4 wajibs which you perform in salat? (2018)

Answer:

Wajib: Wajib means bounden duties. There are 14 Wajibs in Salat. Among them 4 wajibs are given below-

- a) Recitation of surs Fatiha.
- b) Recitatiuon of another sura or part of the Holy Quran along with sura Fatiha.
- c) Standing up straight after Ruku.
- d) Sitting straight between two sijdahs.

3) What is Ahkam of salat? Write any 4 Ahkams which you perform in salat. (2018)

Answer:

Ahkam: The compulsory actions which are required to be done before starting the Salat are known as Ahkam. There are 7 Ahkams in salat. Among them 4 Ahkams are given below-

- a) Purity of body.
- b) Purity of cloths.

- c) To face the Qibla.
- d) Waqt or fixed time for salat

4) Write the names of 5 times salat. Describe any 2times schedule of salat.(2018)

Answer: The names of 5 times Salat are : Fazar, Zohar, Asar, Magrib and Isha.

Fazar: From dawn until just before sunrise. Fazar starts at the beginning of Subhe-Sadik (early morning) and ends on the moment of sunrise, 'Sub e Sadik' means a long white line in the eastern sky seen at the last part of night.

Magrib: After sunset until daylight ends in the western sky.

6) What is called cleanliness? Why will you be clean and tidy? Write 4 sentences about this (2018)

Answer:

cleanliness : Keeping of our body, dress, environment tidy and free from dims is called cleanliness.

I will be clean and tidy because if the body and dress is neat and clean then the mind becomes pure.

4 sentences about Cleanliness

- a) Cleanliness is a part of Iman.
- b) For Allah's Ibadat it is necessary to be pure. Allah loves those who keep themselves clean and pure.
- c) Our great Prophet (Sm) always lived neat and clean, advised all to always remain neat and clean.
- d) Those who remain dirty, offensive smell comes out from their body. No one loves them, They suffer from many diseases.

7) The tradition of Qurbani was started by which Prophet? Write 4 sentences about this ideology. (2018)

Answer: The tradition of Qurbani was started by Prophet Hazrat Ibrahim (A).

Qurbani: Qurbani means nearness, sacrifice and dedication. The sacrifice of domestic, halal animals like camels, buffaloes, sheeps cows, goats etc for getting the satisfaction of Allah is called **Qurbani**. 4 sentences about the ideology of Qurbani are given below:

- a) The spirit of Qurbani is to declare that all of us are ready to sacrifice our life and property for the satisfaction of Allah.
- b) To encourage – inspire Muslims to work in the way of Allah.
- c) Through Qurbani enmity, lust, greed, proudness etc are removed.

- d) One portion of Qurbani's meat is to be distributed among poor people . One portion to the relatives and another for self-consumption.

8) What is called Sahu Sijdah? Why do we offer Sahu Sijdah? Write 2 rules of offering Sahu Sijdah. (2018)

Answer:

Sahu Sijdah Sahu means mistake. If any sort of small mistake takes place in Salat , then a Sijdah is offered to correct that mistake. This Sijdah is called Sahu Sijdah.

We offer Sahu Sijdah for correcting our mistakes if we do any mistake while performing Salat or any wajib item of Salat is dropped.

2 rules of offering Sahu Sijdah:

- We shall recite 'Tashah-hud at the last rakat of Salat. Then we shall go to two Sijdah after offering only one Salam to the right side saying Allahu Akbar.
- After that we shall complete the Salat by offering Salam to the right and left side.

9) What is the name of the 2nd Rukun of Islam? How does Salat keep us away from obscenity and evil deeds? Write 4 sentences about it. (2016)

Answer: The 2nd Rukun of Islam is Salat. Salat has many importance in our life. Salat keeps us away from obscenity and evil deeds. If one performs Salat he fears Allah and don't do any wrong deeds. 4 sentences about it are given below:

- Saying five times of Salat brings our mind to the close contact with Allah and motivates the obedient person to abide by the orders of Allah.
- Prophet (sm) said that If any servant of Allah performs five times of prayer every day, he can not have any vice.
- Salat plays an important role in improving character of a man, correcting unwanted factors in character.
- Allah says, "Surely Salat protects from obsenity, vulgar and sinful works".

10) What is Zakat? How can Zakat remove social inequality? Write 4 sentences about it. (2016)

Answer: Zakat is one of the pillars of Islam. The meaning of the word 'Zakat' is cleanliness, purity and growing. Paying a definite portion of wealth as per principles laid down for it, some eligible poor persons, as Allah asked for it, is called 'Zakat'. Allah says in Al-Quran-

"Establish Salat and Pay Zakat".

Zakat removes social inequality: Zakat removes social inequality by building up a bridge between the rich and the poor. 4 sentences about it are given below:

- The poor have right on the wealth of the rich. Zakat is to distributed among the eligible people.
- Through Zakat the relationship between the poor and the develops, cordial relationship increases.
- Zakat is the bridge of Islam. Through Zakat the gap between the poor and rich decreases.

d) Peace and harmony is established in the society. Unsocial, evil, sinful activities are removed.

We should pay Zakat regularly. If we pay zakat, the equality will be established and inequality will be removed from the society

11)What does Sawm mean? What is the basic aim of sawm? What are the benefits of fasting? Write 4 sentences. (2015,2016)

Answer: Sawm means self-control. To abstain from eating and drinking and some other activities from dawn to dusk is called Sawm. The basic aim of Sawm is to attain Taqwa.

Benefits of fasting/Sawm:

- a) By performing sawm one can attain self-control and self purification.
- b) Sawm gives training and practice to attain Taqwa.
- c) Sawm refrain us from greed, lust, quarrel and all sinful acts.
- d) Sawm creates sympathy and compassion to others.

12)What do you mean by Arkan of Salat? What are the Arkans? (2014)

Answer:

Arkan: There are some Farz activities that should be done in the midst of Salat are known as Arkans of Salat. The number of Arkans are seven. The Arkans of salat are given below-

- a) Beginning of Salat (Namaz) saying Takbir-c-Tahrima or Allahu Akbar
- b) Saying prayers (offering Salat) in standing position, Both male and female should offer their Namaz [prayer] in standing position. But if for any medical reason, it is not possible on the part of someone, he is allowed to offer Namaz sitting on a chair or bed, even by gestures in lying position.
- c) Qirat or recitation from the Holy Quran sura or part of sera
- d) To go to Ruku
- e) To bend down for Sijdah
- f) To sit on the last sitting position
- g) Paying Salam to conclude the Salat

13)Why is it necessary to keep neat and clean? How do you do to keep neat and clean yourself? Write 5 sentences (2017)

Answer: It is necessary to keep neat and clean because cleanliness is a part of Iman. For Allah's Ibadat it is necessary to be pure. If the body and dress is neat and clean then the mind becomes pure.

Ways to keep neat and clean: 5 sentences about how do you do to keep neat and clean myself are given below:

- a) Take a bath everyday.
- b) Wash my teeth everyday.
- c) Clean my dresses.
- d) Clean hands regularly by washing.

- e) Clean my nails and hair regularly.

- d) Saying prayer with devotion and sincerity.
