Types of animal: according to their living place animals are divided into 4 groups. These are-


- 1. Land animals.
- 2. Water animals
- 3. Animals that can fly
- 4. Animal lives both on water and land

Land animals: Animals that live in land is called land animals.

They are 2 types land animals. They are-

- 1. Domestic animals
- 2. Wild animals


Domestic animals: We keep some animalsin our house or farm. Those are called domestic animals.



Domesticanimals are two types. They are-

- 1. Pet animals
- 2. Farm animals.

Pet animals:Some animal those are kept in house is called pet animals. For example,cat, dog, rabbit etc. are pet animals.



Farm animals: Farm animals are those we keep outside house at the farm. Cow, horse, goats etc. are farm animals.



Cows, buffaloes and goats give us milk.


Things we can make from milk:

We can make-

- 1. Butter
- 2. Cheese
- 3. Ghee
- 4. Curd
- 5. Sweet etc.



Wild animals: Animals that live in forests or jungles is called wild animals. Tiger, lion, elephant, monkey etc. are wild animals.



Wild animals are 3 types. They are-

- 1. Plant-eating animals.
- 2. Meat-eating animals.
- 3. Scavengers.

Plant-eating animals: wild animals those live on leaves, grass, roots and green shoots are called plant-eating animals. Monkey, elephant, giraffe etc. are plant-eating animals.



Figure: plant eating animals

Meat-eating animals: some wild animals eat other animals as their food. They are called meateating animals.




Figure: meat eating animals


Characteristics of meat-eating animals:

- 1. They have sharp teeth.
- 2. Meat-eating animals can move very quickly
- 3. They chase and kill other animals for food.

Scavengers: animals those eat dead animals are called scavengers. Hyena, wild dog, vulture eta are scavengers.



Water animals: water animals live in water. Fishes are water animal.



Characteristics of fishes:

- 1. They live in water.
- 2. They can breathe under water.
- 3. They have gills to breathe.
- 4. They use fins for swimming.

Blue whale: The blue whale is the largest animal which can live under water.



Characteristics of blue whale:

- 1. They can live under water.
- 2. It has fins to swim.
- 3. It doesn't have gills.
- 4. It has to come up to the surface to breath.
