1.

4 persons get 24 lozenges

So, 1 person gets $(24 \div 4)$ lozenges

=6 lozenges

Ans: 6 lozenges.

2.

3 persons get 27 taka

So, 1 person gets $(27 \div 3)$ taka

=9 taka

Ans: 9 taka.

3.

5 persons sit on 1 bench

So, 45 persons sit on $(45 \div 5)$ benches

=9 benches

Ans: 9 benches.

4.

In 4 taka a man bought 1 egg

So, In 32 taka a man bought $(32 \div 4)$ eggs

=8 eggs

Ans: 8 eggs.

5.

8 students make 1 group

So, 72 students make $(72 \div 8)$ groups

=9 groups

Ans: 9 groups.

6 pages she reads in 1 day

So, 54 pages she reads in $(54 \div 6)$ days

=9 days.

Ans: 9 days.

4 students sit on 1 bench

So, 24 students sit on $(24 \div 4)$ benches

=6 benches.

2 biscuits he ate in 1 day

So, 8 biscuits he ate in $(8 \div 2)$ days

=4 days.
