Resources: The things in the environment that help us lead productive lives.

Asia: Asia is the largest continent of the world.

Grain crop:Grain crops are crops mostly grass crops that are grown for their edible seeds such as corn, wheat, rice etc.

The chief grain crops of Asia: Rice, wheat, corn, coconut, spices etc.

Largest producer: Asia is the largest producer of rice, and wheat in the world.

Cash crop:Agricultural crop which is sold for export to earn foreign currency called cash crop.For example jute, cotton, rubber, tea, coffee, sugarcane, silk etc.

The chief cash crops of Asia: Jute, cotton, rubber, and tea.

Minerals: Asia has enormous reserves of minerals such as coal, mineral oil, natural gas, bronze, gold, silver, mica etc.

Industry: Asia is quite developed in industry. There are many industrial plants in Japan, South Korea, China, India, Malaysia and Thailand.

The major industries of Asia: Iron, steel, cotton, paper, and jute.

Wild animals of Asia: Asia is home to many wild animals such as tigers, elephants, deer, monkeys and snakes.
