• Earthquake:

Earthquake is a sudden violent shaking of the ground, typically causing great destruction, as a result of movements within the earth's crust or volcanic action.


• Causes of earthquakes:

Earthquakes are caused due to sudden lateral or vertical movements in the crust of the earth.

It happens by both man-made and natural reason.

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- 1. Natural reason:
 - a) Volcanic Eruptions.
 - **b)** Tectonic Movements.
 - c) Geological Faults (and)
 - d) Minor Causes



- 2. Man-made reason:
 - a) Induced by dam
 - b) Mining or extraction of groundwater, oil and gas.
 - c) Waste Storage operations
 - d) Nuclear Bombing etc.



• Effects of earthquakes:


We all know that the effects of earthquake are terrible.

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• Endangered area of Bangladesh:

Bangladesh is at risk of earthquakes because of its geological position. Northeast zone is the most risk (kurigram, Sunamgonj, Sylhet ,hobigonj etc).



• Precautions to face the risk of earthquake / 7 Things we should do at the time of earthquakes:

- a) Stay completely calm.
- b) If you are in bed, cover your head with a pillow.
- c) Shelter under a wooden table or other strong furniture.
- d) Stay away from balconies or furniture that could fall.
- e) If you are in a building, stand under a beam.
- f) After the first shock, leave the building and stay outside.
- g) Keep first aid supplies ready.
