• Riverbank:

The bank of a river or the land above the edge of a river.

• Erosion:

A place where surface tissue has been gradually destroyed by wind, water, or other natural agents.

• Riverbank erosion:

Riverbank erosion is the wearing away of the banks of a river through its flooding or general watercourse.

• The reason of the riverbank erosion:

The riverbank erosion may be both natural or manmade.

1. Natural reasons:

- a) The main natural cause of riverbank erosion is flood.
- b) The extra volume of water in the rivers put pressure on the banks.
- c) Heavy rainfall is another reason for riverbank erosion.
- d) Another responsible factor of erosion is strong current of the river.

According to the Bangladesh Water Development Board the most erosion prone districts are Bogra, Sirajganj, Kurigram, Lalmonirhat, Gaibandha,Rangpur in the country's north, and Chadpur, Manikgonj, rajbari, Shariatpur and Faridpur in Dhaka zone with Tangail and Jamalpur in Mymensingh zone and the coastal areas of Patuakhali.

• Who are responsible for the river banks/ The role of the Government for the riverbank erosion:

The Water Development Board are responsible for protecting the river banks erosion.
