Remain in a specified state or position.

Example: It was cold and wet outside so we stayed at home

You can stay here if you like.

Safe:

Protected from or not involving to danger or risk; not likely to be harmed or lost.

Example: We have to cross the river where it's safe for us to do so

Road Accident:

A road accident refers to any accident involving at least one road vehicle, occurring on a road open to public circulation, and in which at least one person is injured or killed.

Road accident occurs mainly because of the lack of awareness of drivers and people walking on the street.

Ways of crossing the road safely:

It is necessary to be careful at the time of crossing the road because road accident occurs and it mainly occurs because of the lack of awareness of drivers.

- Be careful about self-security while walking.
- Walk on the pavement and not in the middle of the road.
- Use the bridge to cross the road.
- Cross the road at the zebra-crossing, after looking carefully both ways.



Bad effects of road accident:

- Many people die
- Many get disabled
- Loss of money and wealth happens
- The family members of the victim become mentally disturbed

What will we use to cross the road:

- Find the safest place to cross the road.
- Look for traffic and listen.
- If traffic is coming, let it pass.
- When it is safe go straight across, and do not run.
- While passing the road looking right and left.
- Using the zebra crossing.
- Should walk on the footpath instead of walking in the middle of the road.
- Should follow traffic rules.
- Should use the bridge to cross the road.

Prevention of road accident:

- Keep your eyes on the road. When you are driving,
- Never use your cell phone.
- Never, ever drink and drive.
- Avoid construction areas.

- Follow speed limits.
- Follow the rules of the road.
- Ignore aggressive drivers.
