Topic-2: The rights of autistic children

- <u>Rights:</u> Rights are legal, social, or ethical principles of freedom or entitlement.
 Example: A person to be treated with respect and dignity even after being found guilty of a crime.
- <u>Autism</u>: 'Autism' is a developmental disorder characterized by difficulties with social interaction and communication and by restricted and repetitive behavior.

So, the people with autism/disabilities have the right not to be treated inhumanely or against their will and to have input into planning, their care

and support, as well as where they live and in all other aspects of their lives. They also have the right to manage their own finances and make decisions for themselves

• <u>What kind of problem is autism?</u>

Autism is a problem of developmental disorder that is a set of related condition with social interaction, communication and behavior.

• Characteristics of autistic children:

- i) Some autistic children study just like other children.
- ii) Autistic children usually have good health.
- iii) Some autistic children are very talented in mathematics, art, or music.
- iv) They are sensitive to light, sound, speed, touch, smell, taste.
- v) They can get addicted to a particular toy and hung on to it for hours.
- vi) They like to do the same routine, and get hyper if that changes.
- vii) Autistic children have special attraction for a particular thing, and they always keep it with them.
