Writing Something Step by Step:

How to write something chronologically or, step by step?? Suppose, you are making a cup of tea. Then, what are the steps of making a cup of tea? Or, how will you write?

Steps to make a cup of tea:

- 1. Take some water in a kettle and boil it
- 2. Put tea leaves into the boiling water
- 3. Boil it again for 3/4 minutes
- 4. Add milk and sugar
- 5. Stir the mix with a spoon.

Step to make paper birds on string:

- 1. Trace the bird twice on each piece of paper.
- 2. Cut out the bird and draw an eye
- 3. Put glue on one side of a bird
- 4. Lay a piece of string across it.
- 5. Place another bird on top
- 6. Repeat with other paper birds
- 7. Tie the string to the hanger.
