Help	government and NGO came to help
Problems after cyclone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• wasn’t enough safe drinking water and food</li><li>• people became ill</li><li>• people lost their home</li><li>• roads and bridges were broken</li></ul>
Working together	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• all worked together</li><li>• rebuilt the village</li><li>• planted new trees and crops</li></ul>
Babul’s feelings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• happy to see his sister</li><li>• sad about his grandfather</li></ul>
