Linkers:


Linkers are the words that we use to link.

Example:

First, second, third, next, then, following, now, at this point, after, after this, previously, finally etc.

These linkers show the chronology or sequence.

Action Words

Action words are verbs that simply describe actions.

Action verbs and Sentence examples:

Taste – This apple tastes good.

Smell – The perfume smells nice.

Hear – I can hear the children crying.

See – See the notice carefully.

Run – Don't run in the sun.

Walk – Let us walk towards the beach.

Structure of Action Words:

1. In Assertive Sentence

Ex: This apple tastes good.

This apple tastes good.

Sub. Action verb Obj.

2. In Imperative Sentence

Ex: Boil the water for 5 minutes.

Boil the water for 5 minutes
