| Ethnic | A race of people that shares an unique cultural tradition | Racial, tribal | |
| Identity | Who a person is or what a person has, makes him different from others | Individuality, distinctiveness, status, singleness, name | Disparateness, disparity |
| Belief | A strong feeling that is true | Faith, trust | Disbelief, doubt |
| Inspire | To give mental support to be confident to do anything | Encourage, motivate, enthuse | Discourage, demotivate |
