Langalbanda:

Langalbanda is a famous shrine in Bangladesh. It is situated in Narayanganj on the bank of Brahmaputra River. This is an ancient place of pilgrimage. The holy baths take place here on the Shukla Ashtomy day of the month of Chaitra. By taking a bath people can get rid of sins.
