

Tense:

Tense is used to indicate the time of an action. It tells us when something happened.

**Example:**

1. I go to school.
2. I went to the school.
3. I will go to school.



Example no. 1 refers present time, example no. 2 refers past and example no. 3 refers future.

Types of Tense

There are 3 types of Tense. They are:

1. Present Tense
2. Past Tense
3. Future Tense

Simple Present Tense:

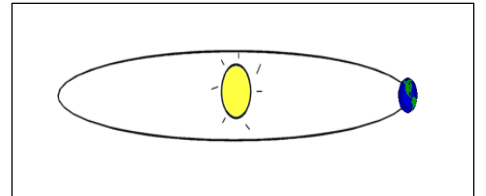
Simple Present Tense indicates habits and general truth.

Example:

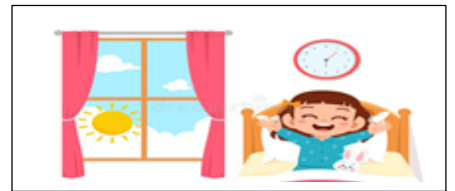
1. The sun rises in the east. (**General Truth**)



2. The earth moves round the sun. (**General Truth**)



3. I wake up early in the morning. (**Habit**)



4. He plays football every day. (**Habit**)



We add 's' or 'es' with verb if there is 'He', 'She', 'It' or 'any name' in the sentence.

Example:

1. He likes**s** to play.
2. She eats**s** fruits.
3. Rima watch**es** television.
4. It rains**s** in the Rainy Season.

We do not add 's' or 'es' with verbs if there is 'I', 'You', 'We', 'They' in the sentence.

Example:

1. I **like** to play.

2. You **eat** fruits.
3. We **watch** television
4. They **play** football.
