

Topic: Tense (Simple Present Tense)

Tense:

Tense is used to indicate the time of an action. It tells us when something





Example:

- 1. I go to school.
- 2. I went to the school.
- 3. I will go to school.



Example no. 1 refers present time, example no. 2 refers past and example no. 3 refers future.

Types of Tense

There are 3 types of Tense. They are:

- 1. Present Tense
- 2. Past Tense
- 3. Future Tense

Simple Present Tense:

Simple Present Tense indicates habits and general truth.



Example:

1. The sun rises in the east. (General Truth)

- 2. The earth moves round the sun. (General Truth)
- 3. I wake up early in the morning. (Habit)

4. He plays football every day. (Habit)

We add 's' or 'es' with verb if there is 'He', 'She', 'It' or 'any name' in the sentence.

Example:


- 1. He likes to play.
- 2. She eats fruits.
- 3. Rima watches television.
- 4. It rains in the Rainy Season.

We do not add 's' or 'es' with verbs if there is 'I', 'You', 'We', 'They' in the sentence.

Example:

1. I **like** to play.











- 2. You eat fruits.
- 3. We watch television
- 4. They **play** football.
