Religion is a set of beliefs, group of ideas and values that are followed and practiced by a person or groups.

Example: The Muslims follow Islam religion. The Hindus follow Hinduism etc.

Types of religion:

Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism and Christianity-these four religions are enlightened in the civilization from the very beginning. People of each religion believe that certain places are particularly holy for them.

The holy place and the holy book for the Muslims:

The Kaa'ba Sharif of Makkah is the holy place for the Muslims. The prophet Hazrat Muhammad (Pbuh) was born in Makkah. The Holy book of Muslims is "The Al-Quran".



The holy places and the holy books for the Hindus:

Varanasi, Kashi, Gaya, Vrindaban, Sitakundu are the holy places for the Hindus. The Holy book of the Hindus are “The Veda and The Geeta”



The holy place and the holy book for the Christians:

Jerusalem is the holy place for the Christians. They believe that Jesus Christ was killed on a cross there. The Holy book of the Christians is “The Bible”



The holy places and the holy book for the Buddhists:

Buddha Gaya and Sarnath are the holy places for the Buddhists. The Holy book of the Buddhists is “ The Tripitok”
