

1.Sources of water

Sources of water can be classified into two groups. Those are:

a) Natural source:

When we get water from natural sources then we called it a natural source of water. Such as sea, river, lake, and rain.

b) Man-made source:

When we get water from a man-made source then we called it a man-made source of water. Such as well, tube-well, tap and pond water, etc.

2. Uses of water:

- c) People use water for washing their clothes.
- d) We use water for industrial purpose.
- e) We use water for growing crops.
- f) Water is also used for fish farming.
