### **Lecture Sheet -1**

<u>Honesty:</u> Honesty means always speaking the truth and living an honest life. Honesty also includes honest thinking and honest activities. It also means not to take other's things illegally.

- ii) Gods and goddesses are pleased with them who are honest.
- iii) It makes a person truthful and good.

**Relation between honesty and religion:** There is a close relation between honesty and religion because, Ishvara and gods and goddesses are pleased with them who have the quality of honesty. Honesty is a part of religion and a moral virtue.
