Lecture Sheet on Sentence and Its Types

Sentence:

A group of words that make complete sense and expresses a thought is called sentence.

Example:

- 1. I live in Bangladesh
- 2. I study regularly
- 3. I read in class IV, etc.

Types of Sentence:

There are 4 kinds of Sentences. They are:

- 1. Assertive Sentence
- 2. Interrogative Sentence
- 3. Imperative Sentence
- 4. Exclamatory Sentence

1. Assertive Sentence:

A sentence that states or declares something is called assertive sentence. It always ends with a full stop (.)

Example:

- a. I went to a market yesterday.
- b. Mother is cooking now.
- c. She is reading.

2. <u>Interrogative Sentence:</u>

The sentence that asks a question is an interrogative sentence.

Example:

- a. What is your name?
- b. What class do you read in?
- c. Do you like chocolate?

3. <u>Imperative Sentence:</u>

When a sentence expresses an order, request, command or suggestion, it is called imperative sentence.

Example:

- a. Please give me a glass of water. (Request)
- b. Shut the door now. (Order)
- c. Let's walk outside. (Suggestion)

4. Exclamatory Sentence:

When a sentence expresses strong feeling, it is called exclamatory sentence.

Example:

- a. What a nice flower it is!
- b. How fan he runs!
- c. What a beautiful dress you have!
