Dynasty:A dynasty is a series of leaders in the same family like the British Royal family.

Discuss about three kings of ancient times:

King Shashanka:

First powerful king of Bengal in 7th century AD.
He established the boundaries of Bengal with the capital as Karnasubarna.
He managed to extend the boarders further during his region.

King Gopala:

1.Gopala was elected to rule Bengal in 8th century.2.He founded the pal dynasty which continued for 400 years.

King Lakshmam Sen:

He ruled Bengal in the 12th century.
He was the forth king of the Sen dynasty.
He was a learned man and a poet.
He was defeated by Bakhtiyar Khilji in 1204 who opened the era of Muslim rules in Bengal.

The social life in ancient times:

1. Villages were at the centre of social life.

2.People were engaged in traditional occupations such as barbers,

blacksmiths, potters, or cobblers.

3. Their religions were Hinduism and Buddhism.

4. Their transports were boats, bullock carts and palanquins.

5. Their food was rice, vegetables, pulses and fish.

6. They enjoyed music, dance, dice and wrestling.

The economic life in ancient times:

1. Agriculture was their main occupation.

2. There was also cottage industry in making cotton and silk garments for export.

3. There was plenty of overseas trade through the sea ports, especially Chattagram.
