At Home:

In one's own house.

Workplace:

A workplace is a location where someone works for his or her employer, a place of employment.

Example: Such a place can range from a home office to a large office building or factory.

Citizen:

Those who live in a state permanently, perform all the duties and responsibilities and enjoy the rights are citizens of that state. **Example:** Citizenship is someone being born in the United States and having access to all the same freedoms and rights as those already living in the US.

Citizens perform their duties and responsibilities to keep the peace and discipline of state.

- Obey state's rules
- Pay taxes regularly
- Never destroy state's property

Patriotism:

To love one's own country is called patriotism. Patriotism is necessary for liberty, sovereignty and over all development of a country.

Characteristics of a patriot:

- He gives top priority to the interest of his country.
- He abides by the rules of the country.
- He plays an important role in preserving national wealth.

Family: A family is a group consisting of two parents and their children living together as a unit.

Practicing democracy in the family:

Democracy brings peace and unity in the family. Engaging children in group decision making helps them learn skills essential for a democracy, like cooperation, compromise, negotiation, and consensus building.

Advantages of practicing democracy in the family:

- Peace and amity in the family will prevail.
- We will learn to respect and consider others' opinion.
- We can take the right decision.
- We will learn to help each other.

Ways of practicing democracy at your home:

- We will take a decision where to go and how to go by discussing with parents, siblings and other family members.
- We will take decision on what to buy and who will buy by discussing with family members.
- What we eat.
- How we want to decorate our house.
