### **Moral Teaching:**

Morality is a part of religion. Teaching related to morality is called moral teaching. Whatever teaching we have, that should develop our morality. Otherwise, our teaching becomes worthless.

# Lesson-1:

**Patriotism:** Patriotism means one's love for one's country. The soil, water, light and air of the country where a man is born, nourishes his/ her and keep alive. Being grown up, people feel love for their motherland. This feeling of love for the motherland is called patriotism. It is a great virtue.

<u>Religion and Patriotism</u>: Patriotism is a part of religion. Religious book says\_\_\_\_\_"Janani janmabhumishcha swargadapi gariasi." That means mother and motherland are superior to heaven.

**<u>Patriot</u>**: A person who has deep feeling of love for his motherland and who works for his country is called patriot. All the great people born on earth were patriots.

### What does a patriot do for his country:

i) He/ She keeps the interest of the country above any self interest.

ii) He/ She works for the good of the country and people.

iii) A patriot cannot sit idle when the country is in danger.

iv) He/ She jumps into action even at the risk of his/her own life and does not hesitate to sacrifice life for the country.
