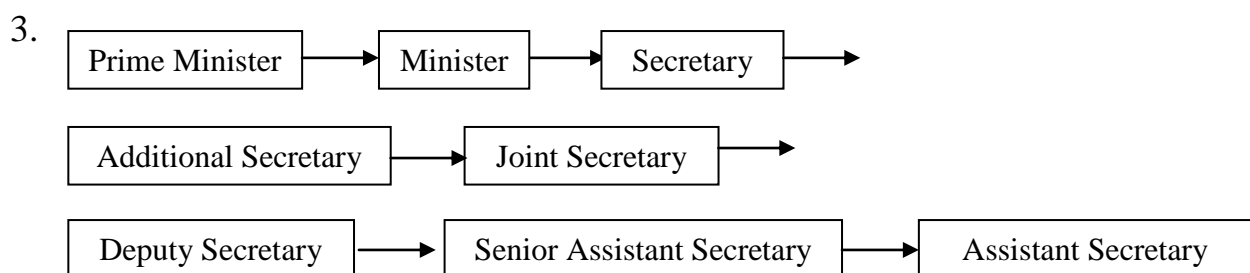


**Creative Question:-**

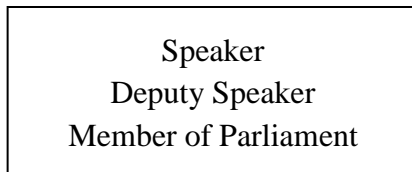

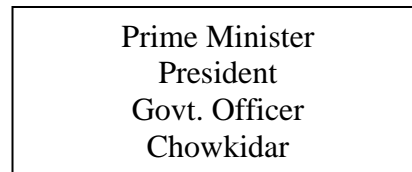

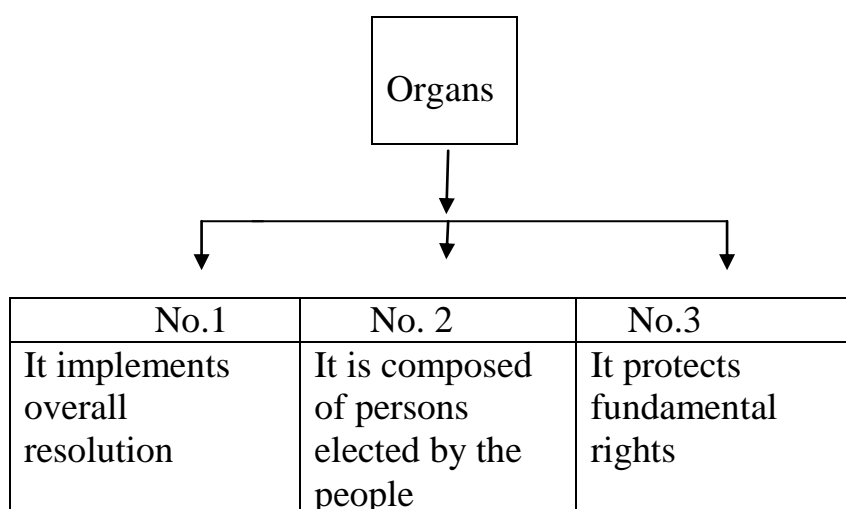
