An adverb is a word that adds meaning to a verb, an adjective or another adverb. It tells when, where or how.

For example:

We went to the movies yesterday. (when)

Put it over there. (where)

The dog barked loudly. (how)

She always arrives early.(when)

He drives carefully. (how)

They go everywhere together. (where)

I have to go now. (when)

Rimi went to his uncle's house. (where)

I have to go now. (when)

This is a fast car. (how)

We first met Nujaima last year. (when)

The cat ran slowly. (how)
