Adjectives are describing words that are used to describe nouns.

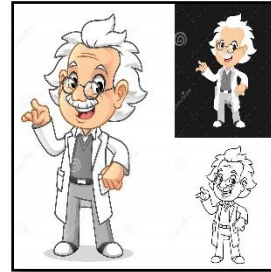

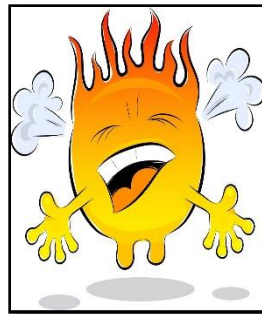

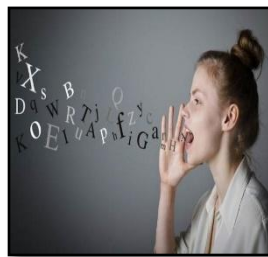
