Forms of water: We know water has three forms: water, water vapour (steam) and ice.

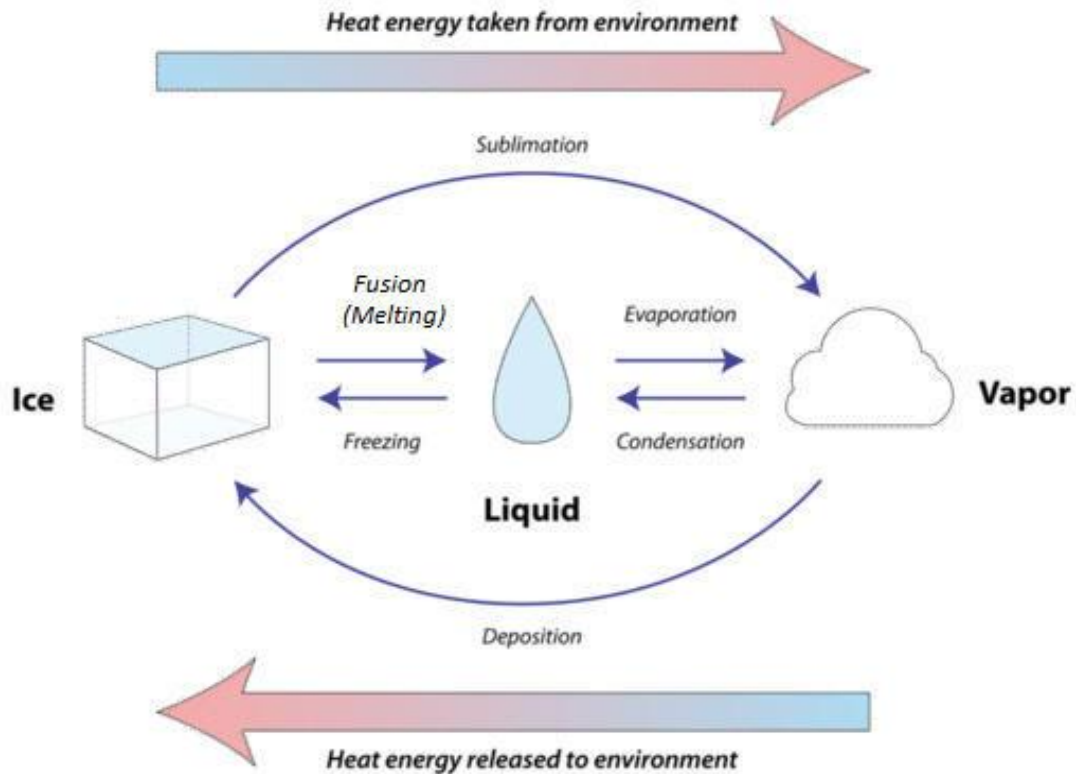


Figure: State of water

Water vapour: When water is heated it turns into water vapour.

Evaporation: The process of changing water into water vapour is called evaporation.

Condenses: When water vapour cools, it forms tiny drops of water which is called condenses.

Condensation: The process of changing water vapour into water drops is called condensation.

Freezing: The process of changing water into ice is called freezing.

Melting: The changing of ice into water is called melting.
