

Preposition

A preposition is a word that the relationship between noun or pronoun and other words in a sentence. Prepositions often tell us the positions of things.



The boy is standing between the chairs.



The puppy is trying to sit beside his sofa.



The girl is hiding under her bed.



The magician put the cat into his hat.



The squirrel is jumping above the ball.



The cat is sleeping inside the box.

Use of Into	Use of Inside
Into usually expresses the movement of	Inside usually used when we refer to
something towards or something else.	the inner part of something.
Example:	Example:
His words put courage <i>into</i> my heart.	I am going to sit <i>inside</i> the car.
Do not come <i>into</i> my room without	We are <i>inside</i> your room.
knocking.	I live inside the city limits.
Mom looked <i>into</i> my eyes when I lie.	Wait for your mom <i>inside</i> the school.
