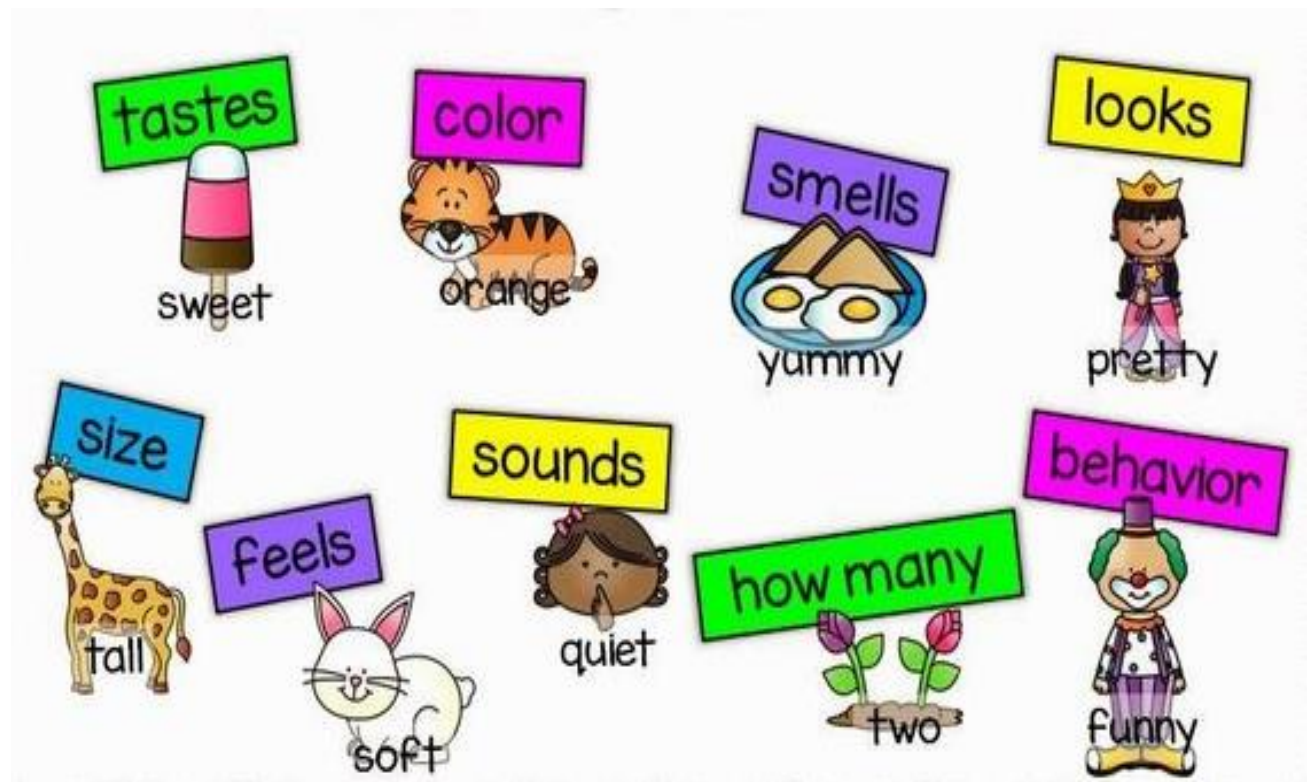

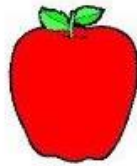
ADJECTIVE

Adjectives are words that are used to describe nouns or pronouns. An adjective makes the meaning of a noun or a pronoun clearer.

quiet library



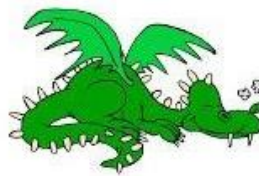

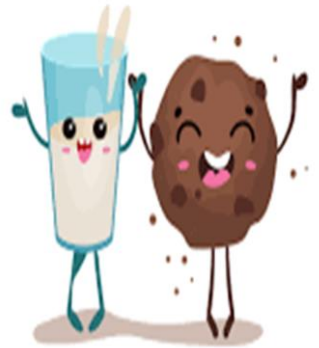
