An= words that starts with vowel sounds, we use *an*

*Example: an orange, an ant, an umbrella, an egg*

#### Use of a

A= if any words dose not starts with vowel sounds, we use *a*

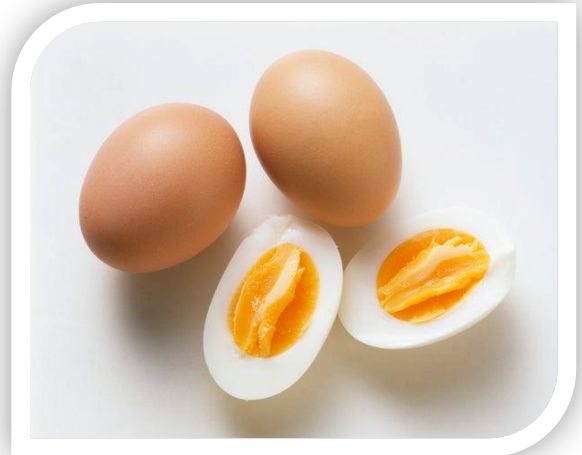
*Example: a book, a sharpener, a dog, a ball*

**Indefinite article:** "In-" means "not," and "definite" means "clear, obvious." "Indefinite" means "not clear, not exact."

The **indefinite article** tells us that the noun is *not* specific. The speaker talks about *any one* of that type of thing.
