Pharmaceutical factory, Agriculture factory, Cottage factory.

b. Cleaner: A person whose job is to clean houses, offices, public places etc. For example, school cleaner, hospital cleaner, Office cleaner, street cleaner.

c. Transport worker: A person who is licensed to operate buses, trucks, taxis or any kind of vehicles publicly called him/her transport worker. For example, bus driver, launch driver, taxi driver, rickshawala, van driver, truck driver.

2. Ans: **Professional occupation:** The term professional occupation refers to anyone who earns their living from performing an activity that requires a certain level of education, skill or training.

a. Office worker: An employee who works in an office, especially one engaged in clerical or administrative work. For example,

1. Account manager
2. Office manager
3. Data Entry Clerk
4. Administrative Assistant
7. Office Assistant

b. Business worker: Business is the activity of making one's living or making money by producing or buying and selling goods and service. Many people work in different types of business office. For example,

1. Food business
2. Catering business.
3. Real Estate business.
4. Stationery business
5. Garments Business.
6. Farming business.
7. Fish business.

c. The Professions: A profession is a type of job that requires advanced education or training. For example,

1. Teacher
2. Engineer.
3. Doctor
4. Pharmacists.
