




1st Person: Who speaks 2nd person: who listens

Relationship between Person and Number


Pronoun	Person	number

We	1 st person	Plural
You	2 nd person	Singular/ plural
He/ she/ it/ any name	3 rd person	Singular
They	3 rd person	plural

*** All the person in plural number use the verb'are' and 'were' and all the person in sigular number use the verb 'is' and 'was' but only 2nd person singular number use 'are'

'were' is the past form of 'are' and is used to show past action

'was' is the past form of 'is' and is used to show past action



1st person

- I play football. (singular)
- We play football. (Plural)

2nd perso

- You play football.
- plural and singular forms are same.

3rd person

- She/he/it/Rohan plays football.(singular)
- They play football. (plural)

*** Here, the verb 'play' has been used. All the person in any number use the verb as it is but only 3rd person singular number use 's' or 'es' at the end of the verb.




