Answer

Natural Disaster: When normal life of people in a locality is disrupted and upset due to some natural calamity (trouble, danger etc) and destruction is called a natural disaster.

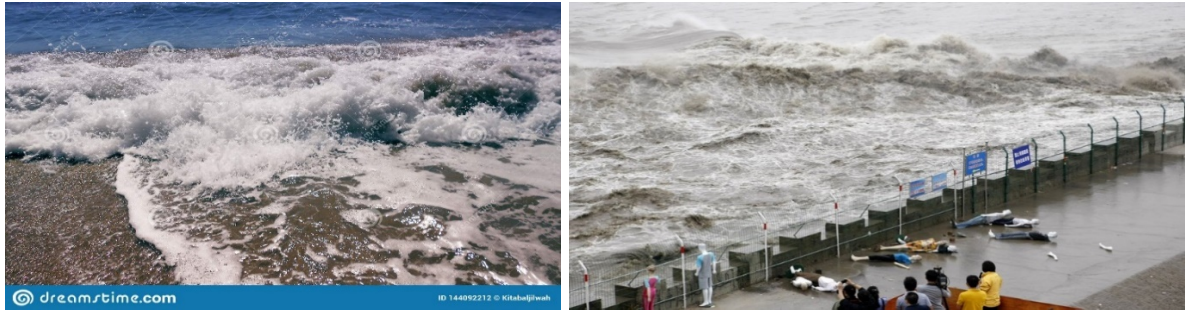
- We often say that a natural disaster has struck a locality. Natural disasters come about suddenly. Man does not have anything to do with such happening. Example: Whirlwind, tidal bore, Tsunami, drought, earthquakes etc are brought about natural disaster. Some pictures are given below to understand these examples.

- **Whirlwind:** It is a column of air moving rapidly round and round in a cylindrical or funnel shape.



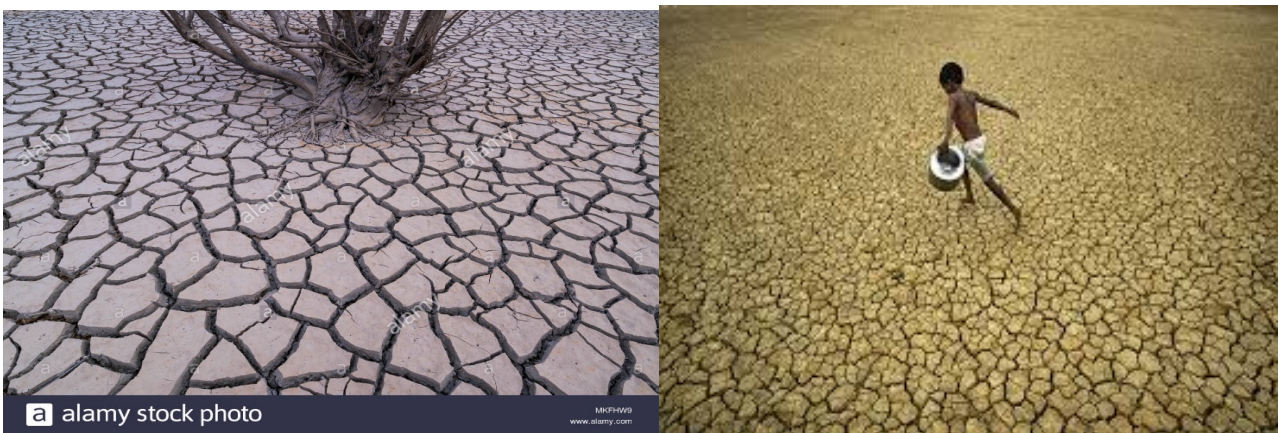
Picture: **Whirlwind**

- **Tidal bore:** Rivers generally flow from higher elevations to the ocean or seas. A **tidal bore** is a situation where the flow of water from the river into the ocean reverses, and the tide pushes water up the river.

- **Drought:** A drought is an event of prolonged shortages in the water supply of the surface water or ground water.



Picture: **Drought**

- **Earthquake:** An *earthquake* is the shaking of the surface of the Earth resulting from a sudden release of energy in the Earth's outermost layer.

- **Tsunami :** A *tsunami* is a series of great sea waves caused by an underwater earthquake, landslide, or volcanic eruption. It is a Japanese word.

2) What damages are caused by the natural disasters?

Or, Explain the damages that will occur due to natural disasters in an area.

Or, How do the disasters hamper in our life?

Answer

Hamper/damages caused by natural disaster: We have come to know about the natural disaster brought about by Aila & Sidar. Almost one fourth of the forests in the Sundarbans have been lost. Natural disaster causes much damage to a country or region.

1. If a tidal bore causes the rise of the sea water level coastal areas are flooded and saline water enters into those areas. As a result, plants & creepers, cropland and fish farms are heavily damaged.
2. Agricultural fields are harmed. Soil loses fertility. Agricultural production decreases.
3. Many people lose their lives.
4. Lots of wealth can be damaged.
5. There was lack of drinking water in the affected areas.
6. Many deadly diseases appeared.
7. Drought and earthquakes cause much destruction to many households and homesteads. It becomes quite difficult for human beings to survive.

3) What steps should be taken for minimizing the damage occurred by the natural disasters?

Or, What steps should be taken to cover the losses caused by the natural disasters?

Or, Describe the steps or actions that could be taken to minimize the losses due to the natural disasters.

Answer

Steps to cover or minimize the damage/losses: We will adopt the following strategies to avoid or minimize the losses that may be caused by natural disasters:

1. We will build dwelling houses, cowsheds and hens for poultry at elevated sites.
2. Preserve food grains and seeds on platforms built at a height inside homesteads.
3. Will raise the sides of the ponds. Will set up latrines and sink tube wells at comparatively high spots.
4. Will deposit essential medicines and dry food stuffs like Chira (flattened and fried rice), Muri (puffed rice), Gur (Mollases).
5. Every member of the family will be taught swimming.
6. If boats are not available while the flood is on, we will build rafts with banana plants.
7. These measures may save us from some troubles caused by natural disasters. It is our moral duty and responsibility to save ourselves and others in the face of natural disasters.

Answer

Ways to help the disaster effected victims/area: People of Bangladesh have been fighting such disasters through ages and survived.
