- **About United Nations:**

The United Nations is an intergovernmental organization that aims to maintain international peace and security, develop friendly relations among nations, achieve international cooperation, and be a center for harmonizing the actions of nations.

- **Rights:**

Rights are legal, social, or ethical principles of freedom or entitlement. **Example:** A person to be treated with respect and dignity even after being found guilty of a crime.

- **Human rights:**



→ Human Rights Symbol

Human rights are basic rights and freedoms that belong to every person in the world, regardless of their race, religion, age, gender or any other status.

**Example:** If we have the right to live safely, so it's also our responsibility not to make suffer other life.

- **Who declared our basic human rights, and when?**

On December 10 in 1948 the United Nations declared our basic human rights.

- **Necessity of human rights:**

Human rights guarantee people the means necessary to satisfy their basic needs, such as food, housing, and education.

- **Ways to protect human rights:**

- i) Identifying human rights
- ii) Embrace the duty to protect and promote human rights
- iii) Learn about human rights
- iv) Participate in local human rights activism
- v) Document human rights violation
- vi) Report local human rights violations to a trusted organization.
