The Legislature : A legislature is a deliberative assembly with the authority to make laws for a political entity such as a country.

The members of a legislature are called legislators. In a democracy, legislators are elected by the people.

Legislature of Bangladesh:

- Name is 'Jatiya Shangshad' or 'Parliament'
- Unicameral parliament
- Total 350 members
- Tenure is 5 years
- Conducted by speaker and deputy speaker elected by members of parliament.



Power & Functions of the Parliament:

- The legislative power
- Power to formation of the government
- The financial power
- The power of judicial affairs
- The power of electoral affairs
- The power to protect and amendment of constitution
- Miscellaneous power

Procedure of parliament:

- The administrative departments are accountable to the parliament for all sorts of administrative system.
- The parliament may praise the government for their good job and also criticize them for wrong action.
- In democratic way parliament establishes its control over the government.
- If parliament loses confidence in a minister or prime minister, they are forced to resign.
