The Judiciary : The judiciary is the system of courts that interprets, defends and applies the law in the name of the state.

The judiciary can also be thought of as the mechanism for the resolution of disputes.

Legislature of Bangladesh:

- ➤ The Judiciary of Bangladesh consists of a Supreme Court, subordinate courts and tribunals.
- ➤ The Supreme Court of Bangladesh is comprised of the Appellate Division and the High Court Division.
- > Supreme Court is the highest court of Bangladesh. other courts and tribunals are subordinate to it.





Functions of the Judiciary:

- > To dispense justice
- > To make law
- > To protect fundamental rights
- > To expound and apply fundamental laws
- > To safeguard the constitution
- > To settle disputes
- > To advise the administrative department

Role of Judiciary:

- > Take necessary arrangement to protect human rights
- ➤ Works as safeguard of personal freedom of people
- > Protecting civic rights of people
- > Protect the constitution and rules of law

Appoinment Procedure of Judges:

- ➤ Chief Justice >> appointed by president
- ➤ Other Judges of high court >> appointed by president
- Subordinate judges >> appointed by competitive examinations
