Introduction of Hadith

The Holy Proohet (Sm.) has narrated the five main based of Islam. These are

- 1. Iman (Faith)
- 2. Salat (Prayer)
- 3. Zakat (Wealth-Tax)
- 4. Hajj (Pilgrimage)
- 5. Sawm (Fasting)

Teachings

- 1. The fundamentals of Islam are five in number.
