Defination of Ijma

Ijma is an Arabic word. Its etymological meanings are – to agree, to united, to establish the agreed opinion etc. In a practical sense, to come to a common position on a matter or discourse is called Ijma.

Importance and Legitimacy of Ijma

In the Islamic Shariat, Ijma is very important. It stands next to Al-Quran and hadith. It is the third source of Shariat and an irrefutable tool.
