Volume measures

Volume measures capacity. For example, the volume of a bowl is the amount of space inside the bowl or how much water, for example it would take to fill the bowl.

The most common units of volume are millilitres (ml) and liters (L).


A single raindrop contains about 1 millilitre of liquid:

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
Time measures

Time is a used to quantify, measure or compare the duration of events or the intervals between them, and even, sequence events.

We measure time in seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, months and years with clocks and calendars.

The hour hand, the shorter of the two hands, completes 1 rotation in 12 hours in a normal 12-hour analogue. The minute hand, the longer hand, completes 1 rotation 60 minutes. The second hand, the longer hand, completes 1 rotation 60 seconds






60 seconds = 1 minute

60 minute = 1 hour
