

Sentence:

A group of words that make complete sense and expresses a thought is called sentence.

Note:

- We usually start a sentence with capital letter
- End up with a punctuation mark. For Example: Full Stop (.), Question sign (?), Exclamation Mark (!) etc.

Example:

1. I read in class – 2.
2. We live in Bangladesh.
3. He likes Chocolate.
4. Red is my favourite colour.
5. I like flowers.

Question: “a Ben pet dog has.” Is it a Sentence? Why or Why not?

Types of Sentence:

There are 4 kinds of Sentences. They are:

1. Assertive Sentence
2. Interrogative Sentence
3. Imperative Sentence
4. Exclamatory Sentence
