- But if you go closer it looks like a big cheese-ball covered with holes and rocks.

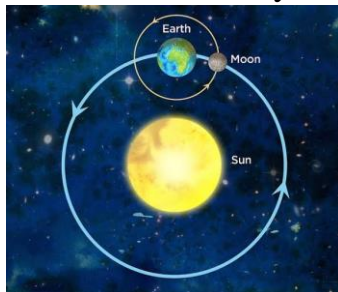
The Sun:
