**Syllable and Its Type**

**Syllable:**

Syllable is a part of a word with one vowel sound.

[\* Note: It helps to spell/pronounce a word. All words have syllables. A word might have one, two or more syllables. ]

**Types of Syllables:**

There are 3 types of syllables. They are:

1. Mono Syllable
2. Di - Syllable
3. Tri - Syllable

**1. Mono Syllable:**

A word consisting of one syllable is called mono syllable.

**Example:**

Book, pen, cat, chair, dog etc.

**2. Di – Syllable:**

A word consisting of two syllables is called di – syllable.

**Example:**

Monkey, Circle, Careful, Twenty etc.

**3. Tri – Syllable:**

A word consisting of three syllables is called tri – syllable.

**Example:**

Beautiful, Important, Popular, Banana etc.
