Agriculture: Agriculture refers to the production of crops for man’s benefit.

The name of main agricultural products of Bangladesh:

Rice, jute and tea.

The names of other agricultural products: Wheat, mustard, many types of pulses, vegetables and spices etc.

Cash crop: A crop produced for earning money by exporting it. For example jute and tea.

The names of some cash crops: Jute, tea, silk etc.

Forest: A forest is a large area which covered with trees.

Types of forest: In Bangladesh, there are three main areas of forest. These are

1. Hilly forest
2. Shalforest
3. Sundarban

Description about Hilly forest:

1. It is situated in hilly areas.
2. Different types of trees, bamboo and cane are grown here.
3. Elephants, monkeys and wild bears are there up in the hills.

Description of Shalforest:

- 1.It is located in Modhupur, Bhawal and Barendra.
- 2.Wood from the Shal trees is used to build houses and make poles for power lines.
- 3.Tn these areas we also find different fruits and wood trees other than Shal.

Description about Sundarban:

- 1.It is situated in the south of Khulna division
2. Here we find shundori, gewa, golpata, keora trees.
- 3.The world famous Royal Bengal Tigers also live in Sundarban.
