River: A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river.

The rivers of Bangladesh: There are many rivers in Bangladesh. Some are big and some are small. The rivers start from the hills and flow down.

The names of five big rivers of Bangladesh: Padma, Meghna, Jamuna, Karnafuli, Brahmaputra.

Alluvial soil: A fine grained fertile soil deposited by water flowing over flood plains or in river beds.
