3. Ans: The names of all seasons in Bangladesh are summer, rainy, autumn, late autumn, winter and spring.
4. Ans: According to temperature and rainfall, the climate of Bangladesh are divided into three types.
5. Ans: The summer runs from March to May in Bangladesh.
6. Ans: The temperature rises upto 35 degrees celsius during the summer in Bangladesh.
7. Ans: April is the hottest month in Bangladesh.
