Bangladesh's season: There are six seasons in Bangladesh. These are Summer, rainy, autumn, late autumn, winter and spring.

According to temperature and rainfall:

The climate of Bangladesh are divided into three main types. These are summer, rainy, and winter.

The characteristics of Bangladesh's season:

Summer season:

1.Month: March to May.

2.Temperature: Upto 35 degrees celsius.

3.Hottest month: April

4.Storms: The storm begins with Kalbaishakhi in April or May.

Rainy Season:

1.Month: June to October.

2. Heavy rain: The monsoon blows northwards from the Bay of Bengal,

bringing heavy rain.

3.Average rainfall: 203 centimetre.

Winter Season:

1.Month: November to February.

2.Average temperature: 18 degrees celsius

3.Coldest area: North

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
