**Bangladesh's season:**There are six seasons in Bangladesh.These are Summer, rainy, autumn, late autumn, winter and spring.

**According to temperature and rainfall:**

The climate of Bangladesh are divided into three main types.These are summer, rainy, and winter.

**The characteristics of Bangladesh's season:**

**Summer season:**

1.**Month:** March to May.

2.**Temperature:** Upto 35 degrees celsius.

3.**Hottest month:** April

4.**Storms:** The storm begins with Kalbaishakhi in April or May.

**Rainy Season:**

1.**Month:** June to October.

2.**Heavy rain:** The monsoon blows northwards from the Bay of Bengal, bringing heavy rain.

3.**Average rainfall:** 203 centimetre.

**Winter Season:**

- 1.Month:** November to February.
- 2.Average temperature:** 18 degrees celsius
- 3.Coldest area:** North
