1. Ans: Topography means the nature and formation of the land, especially its height.
2. Ans: A hilly area where has many hills.
3. Ans: The hilly areas of Bangladesh are located in the south-east and north-west regions.
4. Ans: The name of the highest peak of Bangladesh is Tazin Dong.
5. Ans: The height of Tazin Dong is 1280 metres.
6. Ans: The name of the second highest peak of Bangladesh is Keokradong.
7. Ans: The height of Keokradong is 1230 metres.
8. Ans: Some names of hilly areas of Bangladesh are Khagrachari, Rangamati, Bandarban and Chittagong.
9. Ans: Tazin Dong is located in Bandarban.
10. Ans: Below hilly areas are areas of high land with old alluvial soil where silt was deposited from rivers long ago.
11. Ans: A plain is a broad area of relatively flat land. The plains have new alluvial soil and slop down from north to south. Many rivers flow through these plains and they are often flooded, so the land formed with new alluvial soil, is very fertile.
12. Ans: Keokradong is located in Bandarban.
13. Ans: The rivers originate from the plain areas.
14. Ans: Most of the rivers flow from north to south direction.
